1. Call to Order

Mayor Brown called the meeting to order.

2. Declarations of Conflict of Interest

No conflicts were declared.

3. Approval of Agenda

It was suggested that the item to be held in Closed session be discussed in the Open session. Moved by Councillor Duffy and seconded by Councillor Ramsay that the agenda be approved as amended. Carried.

4. Proposed Items

a) Public Works Resolution

Moved by Councillor Mike Duffy Seconded by Councillor Terry MacLeod

RESOLVED:

That, due to the urgency to repair a collapsed catch basin on Pownal St., the submission of Island Coastal Services in the amount of \$39,228.16 (all taxes included) be accepted, and

That this expenditure be charged to the 2019 Capital budget dated March 21st, 2019,

And further that the Mayor and CAO are hereby authorized to execute any standard contracts/agreements to implement this resolution.

b) Utility Resolutions

Moved by Deputy Mayor Jason Coady Seconded by Councillor Julie McCabe

RESOLVED:

WHEREAS, the City of Charlottetown passed a policy resolution of April 10, 2000 "that City Council confirm its policy not to entertain applications for water service to properties outside the municipal boundary of the City of Charlottetown" without first receiving approval from City Council to do so,

And that City Council approves the request for water and sewer servicing to PID #689000, a proposed lot to be subdivided at the corner of Royalty Road and Sleepy Hollow Road, within the Community of Miltonvale Park,

And further that the costs associated with the development be paid by the developer and services be billed with a 25% premium as a surcharge for services provided outside the City of Charlottetown municipal boundary.

In response to a question raised, the Utility Manager clarified that the request is for a single lot which will be subdivided into two lots.

RESOLVED:

That the City of Charlottetown accepts the proposal for Engineering Services from CBCL Ltd. in the amount estimated at \$235,830.50 (taxes included) for the Sewer Lift Stations Rehabilitation and Enhancement Project,

And that this be expensed out of the 2019/20 Utility Capital Budgets,

And further that the Mayor and CAO are hereby authorized to execute standard contracts/agreements to implement this resolution.

RESOLVED:

That the change order requests for electrical work at the Miltonvale Wellfield Mechanical/Electrical Project be approved in the in the amounts of \$94,052.98 (HST included) for Sine Wave Filters, and \$3,365.85 (HST included) for Net Metering.

And that the Mayor and CAO are hereby authorized to execute standard

contracts/agreements to implement this resolution.
