City of Charlottetown, PEI A Bylaw to Amend the City of Charlottetown Tree Protection Bylaw Bylaw # 2019-TP-01A

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of the City of Charlottetown as follows:

PART I - INTERPRETATION AND APPLICATION

1. Title

1.1. This bylaw shall be known and cited as the "Tree Protection Amendment Bylaw."

2. Purpose

2.1. The purpose of this bylaw is to amend the City of Charlottetown's Tree Protection Bylaw to clarify 1) Public tree protection within the City of Charlottetown 2) Tree Protection Zone signage requirements 3) Emergency pruning of City trees and 4) Minor typographical errors.

3. Authority

3.1. Pursuant to Part 5, Section 134 (1) – Revision of Bylaws of the Municipal Government Act R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. M-12.1.

4. Definitions

- 4.1. In this bylaw, any word and term that is defined in the *Municipal Government Act R.S.P.E.I.*, the *Provincial Environmental Protection Act, R.S.P.E.I.* 1988, E-9, the *Pesticides Control Act, R.S.P.E.I.* 1988, P-4 or the *City of Charlottetown Tree Protection Bylaw* has the same meaning as in that Act or Bylaw.
- 5. Section 2 Purpose of the City of Charlottetown Tree Protection Bylaw is hereby amended by the following:
 - 5.1. Amend subsection 2.1 (a) to read as follows: "recognize the importance of trees as green infrastructure and to protect trees on City-Owned Property in the City of Charlottetown."
- 6. Section 4 Application of the City of Charlottetown Tree Protection Bylaw is hereby amended by the following:
 - 6.1. Amend subsection 4.1 (a) to read as follows: "all trees located on or abutting City-Owned Property in the City of Charlottetown;"
 - 6.2. Amend subsection 4.1 (b) to read as follows: "Heritage Trees and Protected Trees on City-Owned Property and private property in the City of Charlottetown;"

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- 6.3. Amend subsection 4.1 (c) to read as follows: "diseased, Infested or Hazardous trees on City-Owned Property and private property in the City of Charlottetown; and"
- 7. Section 7 Tree Maintenance of the City of Charlottetown Tree Protection Bylaw is hereby amended by the following:
 - 7.1. Amend subsection 7.2 to read as follows: "Notice will be served to the property owner three days in advance of any work (tree planting, removals or pruning) taking place on private property, with the exception of emergency situations"
- 8. Section 8 Restrictions of the City of Charlottetown Tree Protection Bylaw is hereby amended by the following:
 - 8.1. Amend typographical error in subsection 8.3 (h); replace "brake" with "break"
- 9. Section 10 Tree and Root Protection Zone (TPZ) Construction of the City of Charlottetown Tree Protection Bylaw is hereby amended by the following:
 - 9.1. Amend subsection 10.1 (d) to read as follows: "a minimum of two signs will be placed on the fencing stating that this is a Tree Protection Zone, as per Appendix 1. Signs are available to borrow from the City of Charlottetown;"
 - 9.2. Add new subsection 10.2
 - "In some cases, work in the TPZ in unavoidable. In these situations, the TPZ must be discussed with the City Arborist or designate. It may be necessary to implement other tree protection measures such as horizontal root protection, mulching of root zone or excavation of soil around roots using water, air or hand-digging."
- 10. Section 24 Emergency Removal of the City of Charlottetown Tree Protection Bylaw is hereby amended by the following:
 - 10.1. Amend subsection 24.1 by adding **24.1 (d)** "Utility companies need to prune or remove trees to restore existing power to a building."
- 11. Appendix 1 of the City of Charlottetown Tree Protection Bylaw is hereby amended by the following:
 - 11.1. Within Appendix 1, replace the Tree Protection Zone (TPZ) graphics with a new graphic and title the page "Tree Protection Zone (TPZ) Signage"

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Part II - Approval and Adoption

12. Effective Date

12.1. This Tree Protection Amendment Bylaw, #2019-TP-01A shall be effective on the date of approval and adoption below.
