A Bylaw to Repeal Certain Bylaws
Bylaw # 2021-RCB-01

Adopted Jan 10, 2022

1. Title

1.1. This bylaw shall be known and cited as a “Bylaw to Repeal Certain Bylaws.”

2. Authority

2.1. Pursuant to Section 126 of the *Municipal Government Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. M-12.1., Power to amend and repeal bylaw or resolution.

3. Purpose

3.1. When a bylaw has no further need, action or consequence it is redundant and should be repealed. Occasionally, bylaws are repealed but not replaced therefore a repeal bylaw should be duly passed.

4. Repeal of Existing Bylaw

4.1. The City of Charlottetown Bylaw to Repeal Certain Bylaws which was initially approved and adopted by City Council on August 26, 1997; amended Feb. 8 & Oct. 12, 1999, Oct. 17, 2002 and Mar. 31, 2004 shall be repealed and replaced with this “Bylaw to Repeal Certain Bylaws”, #2021-RCB-01.

5. Effective Date

5.1. This “Bylaw to Repeal Certain Bylaws,” Bylaw# 2021-RCB-01, shall be effective on the date of approval and adoption below.
