To be eligible for consideration by the City for a Rebate under the Flood Protection Rebate Program (the "Program"):

- 1. Applying does not guarantee a rebate. Rebates are issued on a "first-come, first-served" basis, and are subject to funding limits.
- 2. To be eligible for consideration for a rebate under the Program:
 - a. You must be the registered owner of a single-family residential, duplex or triplex property within the City of Charlottetown.
 - b. The rebate is available only to existing homes, not homes in the planning stages or currently under construction.
 - c. All downspouts, sump pumps, sub-soil drainage, foundation drainage, and area drains on your property must be disconnected form the City's sewer system.
 - d. You must submit your application within six (6) months of completion of the installation of the flood protection device, as indicated on the invoice of the licensed contractor who performed the installation.
- 3. In applying to the Program, and as a condition of eligibility for a rebate, I understand and agree to the following:
 - a. I am solely responsible for the work being done on my property.
 - b. The City assumes no liability whatsoever relating to the work being undertaken to be eligible for the rebate, and the work cannot be considered a guarantee that basement flooding will not occur.
 - c. The City of Charlottetown does not:
 - i. Endorse specific brands, products, dealers or contractors
 - ii. guarantee materials, workmanship, or performance of the eligible flood protection devices
 - d. The City of Charlottetown reserves the right, at any time, to cancel the Program or the payment of any rebates under it in the event that sufficient funding is no longer available under the Program, or the Program is cancelled by the City.

- e. By signing this application, the property owner agrees to assume all financial and other responsibility for all work whatsoever in respect to and related to installation, performance, maintenance, repair and use of the flood prevention device(s) which may be eligible for a for a rebate under the Program, including, without limitation, the selection of the installers and any consequences arising from the installation of the works and the compliance with all laws in respect to such works.
- f. I fully and completely, without qualification, agrees hereby to waive and release and shall be deemed to have waived and released the City of Charlottetown, its officials, officers, employees, agents and representatives (collectively, the "City") from and against any claims or liabilities whatsoever including, without limitation, any damages, costs and liability for any and all loss, injury or damage to any property or person, whether direct, special, consequential, indirect or of any other nature, in connection with or related to the installation of a flood prevention device or related to participation in this Program (collectively, "Claims").
- g. I will not make any Claims or take any action against the City and agree to indemnify the City against any Claims made or taken by someone else.
- h. If any incorrect or deceptive information, statement or representation is found in this application or the accompanying documents, the City is entitled to:
 - i. reject my application
 - ii. demand full and immediate repayment of any rebate money paid to me
 - iii. prosecute me or take other legal action against me

Subject to any reserved rights of the City, no payment of a rebate under this Program shall be made unless all terms and conditions of this application and Program have been met.
