    - 1. <u>385 Queen Street (PID #356923)</u> *Greg* Request to reduce the required lot frontage from 98.4 ft to approximately 94.1 ft in order to demolish the existing duplex dwelling and construct a 10-unit apartment dwelling, two (2) of which would be affordable dwelling units.

    - <u>506 Malpeque Road (PID #402735)</u> Robert Request to reduce the minimum side yard setback requirement of 1.8 metres (6ft) to approximately 0.9 metres (3ft) in order to convert an existing accessory structure into a garden suite, which is a self-contained dwelling unit, and located in the side yard of the existing singledetached dwelling.

8. Lot 19-1 Sherwood Road (PID #1107200) Robert

Request to rezone the subject property from the Comprehensive Development Area (CDA) Zone to the Industrial Business Park (M-3) Zone and amend Appendix "A" the Official Land Use Map from Comprehensive Development Area to Industrial in order to develop two industrial developments; a heavy truck maintenance shop and a construction company office both of which will have ancillary warehousing and outside storage.

9. <u>35 Connolly Street (PID #358572)</u> Greg

Request to rezone the subject property from the Shopping Centre Commercial (C-3) Zone to the Mixed-Use Corridor (MUC) Zone in order to construct a single-detached dwelling on the vacant property. This is a request to proceed to public consultation.

 <u>53 Towers Road (Lot 2014-5) (PID #1076702)</u> Laurel Request to amend a comprehensive development plan and amend a development agreement to increase the density on the lot from 60 to 62 units.
